

Dear Parents and Carers,

The PSFA are organising a Bag2School collection next week.

IMPORTANT: The bags will now be collected on THURSDAY 16TH JULY and NOT as advertised on the bags and in the school calendar.

You should receive a blue bag2school via your child today. Please fill with unwanted clothing. You can also use additional black sacks once you've filled your blue bag! The more we collect in weight the more we earn for the school. We usually make at least £300 so it is a very good way for us to make some money for the school whilst giving parents a chance to have a clear out.

The scheme collects good quality second hand clothing for re-use.

They accept:

- Men's, ladies and children's clothing
- Paired shoes (tied together or elastic band around)
- Handbags, ties, belts, hats and soft toys
- Jewellery

They do NOT accept:

- Duvets, bedding, household linen
- Pillows and cushions
- Carpets, rugs and mats
- Curtains
- Towels
- Soiled or wet clothing
- School uniform
- Corporate clothing and work wear
- Shredded or off cuts of textile

Unfortunately any rejected goods will be left at school and we have no real means of disposing of them, so if you could stick to the rules it would help us out enormously.

The bags will be collected from school on Thursday 16th July by 9.15 am so please return the bags at the following times:

- Wednesday 15th July from 6.30–7.30pm at the Community Room – this is the best option if you have a car load.
- Thursday 16th July from 8.30-9.00am in the Small Hall. Note that cars are not allowed into the staff car park at this time so you will have to carry your sacks through the playground or car park.
