



Literacy:

We will continue to use talk for write strategies to build our understanding of sentence structure and how to use basic punctuation.

Please practise phonics daily with your children at home, reminding them of the digraphs, trigraphs and split digraphs (also known as magic 'e'). You might like to play games on the phonics play website.

Art: We will examine the image 'Castle and the Sun' by Paul Klee; compare the image to real castles in the UK and then recreate the image using crayons and watercolours.

Design and Technology

We will design, create and evaluate Castle models with moving parts including key features.

Science:

Seasonal Change: We will continue to observe seasonal changes, focusing on spring.

Everyday Materials: We will be thinking about the properties of everyday materials. We will be learning to use a table and tally to record data.

RE:

We will learn that Jesus is special to Christians and exploring how his welcome on Palm Sunday shows this.

Music: We will develop our ability to distinguish between higher and lower sounds and create simple melodic patterns.

Maths:

We will consider Number: Place value within 50 and including multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will also learn about measurement, including length, height, weight and volume.

We will capture a range of architecture using different art and craft techniques and conclude by meeting the Duke of Normandy and helping him to plan his next castle!
