



# Plants

**Science:** In our garden we will grow vegetables and flowers and look at the stages of the growth of a plant. We will learn the names of common plants and trees.

**Maths:**

We will be learning about how to measure mass and capacity. Then we will move onto multiplication, division and fractions.

**Geography:** We will be studying the area around school, thinking about how to read a simple maps and how we could improve the local area. We will also be starting to use our fieldwork skills to help us find out about the local area.

**PSHCE:** Healthy lifestyles – learning how to be healthy through what you eat and how you live.

**Art and DT:** We will examine and sketch close up views of plants. We will design and create pollen sculptures out of clay. We will create flower models using junk modelling.

**Music:**

We will continue to learn about pitch. We will also start to think about how to compose our own pieces of music using informal notation.

**Literacy:**

This term we will be reading some non-fiction books about growing. We are focussing on using describing words and joining words (and, but, when, so, because) to make sentences more interesting.

Please continue to work on phonics and reading each day with your child as this affects all of their learning.

**PE:**

**When it is dry we will teach P.E. outdoors this term so outdoor kit is essential. Please check your child has suitable shoes for running.**

Games – fundamental skills e.g. running, controlling, throwing, catching, kicking, striking and changing direction.

**RE:** What did Jesus teach? Is it possible to be kind all the time?

**Computing:**

We will be introducing coding, including making our own characters and writing a program to move the character.

**Please remember** your child needs to:

- Bring their book bag every day.

- As the weather gets warmer, please provide your child with a sun hat and sun cream.
