<p>Trip to the supermarket</p> <p>Take a trip to your local supermarket. Look at all the foods that have the Fairtrade logo on. Can you find the country of origin on the items?</p>	<p>Fairtrade food</p> <p>Design and draw the packaging for a Fairtrade product. How will you make it stand out on the supermarket shelves?</p>	<p>Fairtrade farming</p> <p>Build a farm out of any construction materials (e.g. Lego, wooden blocks, plasticine). What Fairtrade crops would you farm? How would you look after your farmers?</p>
<p>Fairtrade alphabet</p> <p>Can you think of vocabulary related to Fairtrade for each letter of the alphabet?</p> <p>This could be countries involved in Fairtrade, supermarkets, product names and key ideas.</p>	<p>My pet banana</p> <p>Write your own imaginative poem about a Fairtrade product (or choose another Fairtrade product).</p> <p>Create a word bank for descriptive words and phrases first. How will you present your poem?</p>	<p>Sketching</p> <p>Choose a crop (e.g. bananas) and a country. Find a picture of a farm or plantation so that you can imagine what the farming of that produce looks like. Make a sketch of the one you have chosen.</p>
